AEROSPACE CONGRESS AACII NÜRNBERG TOGETHER FOR A BETTER WORLD



We are heading to the top! - was the clear message from around 300 participants from the aerospace industry, the new key sector for Germany as a high-tech location. In the hall of the Meistersingerhalle Nuremberg, leading representatives in the dialog between science and practice spoke on stage, such as ESA, Diehl, Schaeffler and many more in the Aviation Space Satellites - New Generation Forums and in the Expert Summit. In the exhibition area, SMEs from the region and 20 countries presented themselves at the second AACII Congress with "hidden champions", universities, colleges, the Fraunhofer Institute and the VDI and VDE associations.
